## FEATURES

- ▶ Class 3A (3R, IIIA) laser.
- ▶ 500m (1600ft) mx night time range. Effective range of 20m+ (65ft+) during daylight.
- ▶ 5mWatt, 532nm wavelength.

## DIRECTIONS

1. Press button to turn laser on, beam will only shine while button is pressed.
2. Twist top ring to adjust beam. A more focused beam will provide greater daylight range.
3. Screw off bottom of laser to access battery. Insert battery negative side first.
4. Laser comes with 2 (3.7v) lithium rechargeable batteries and a charger with a power cord.
5. For a full charge, leave batteries plugged in for 8 hours.



## LASER SAFETY

- ▶ Never point laser beam at anyone, or look directly into the beam.
- ▶ Do not aim laser at surfaces that could reflect light back, such as mirrors or mirrored surfaces.
- ▶ Never aim laser into the cockpit of an aircraft, or at other vehicles or vessels.
- ▶ Keep laser out of childrens reach.
- ▶ If used incorrectly, lasers can cause flash blindness or even permanent eye damage.

## BATTERY SAFETY

- ▶ Lithium-ion batteries can overheat, catch fire or explode is they are not charged in a safe manner.
- ▶ Allow batteries to come to room temperature before charging.
- ▶ Never attempt to charge a battery in below freezing temperatures.
- ▶ Do not exceed the recommended charging time.

- ▶ Use the supplied charger. If you are in need of a replacement charger, please contact Margo Supplies.
- ▶ Do not use uncertified chargers.
